

Below is a screen shot showing that in both 2009 and 2010 GSUSA donated \$100,000 to WAGGGS as part of their World Thinking Day project through their Juliette Low Fund. In addition GSUSA made payments marked as “WAGGGS scholarships” to support girls’ travel to WAGGGS World Centres. GSUSA also made large payments marked as “destinations scholarships” that were used to fund girls’ travel which may have included travel for girls to lobby at the United Nations.
