**Fund Raising**

Method(s) Used:

Direct mail, telemarketing, special events, print advertisements, grant proposals, Internet appeals, door to door, planned giving, cause-related marketing, and membership appeals.

Fund raising costs were 21% of related contributions. (Related contributions, which totaled \$46,832,995, are donations received as a result of fund raising activities.)

**Amnesty** incurred joint costs of \$4,494,210 for informational materials and activities that included fund raising materials. Of those costs, \$4,146,204 was allocated to program expenses and \$348,006 was allocated to fund raising expenses.
